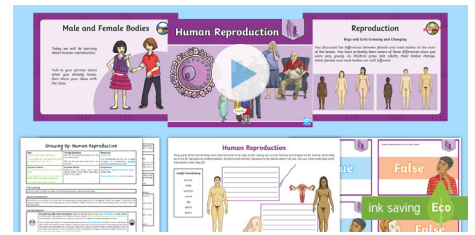


## 1. Human Reproduction

I can describe male and female body parts and explain what these are for.

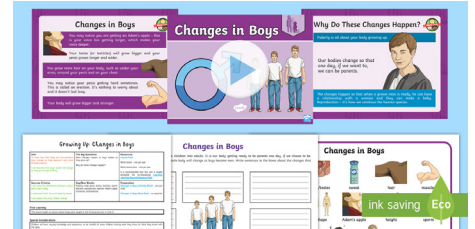


## 2. Changes in Boys

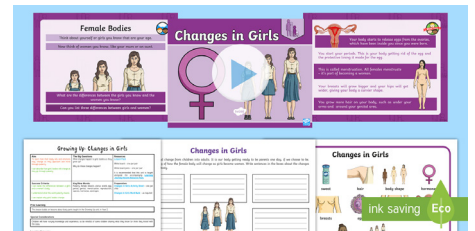


## 3. Changes in Girls

- White board pens - one per pair

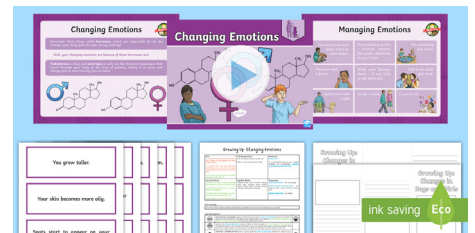


## 4. Changing Emotions

## 5. Relationships and Families

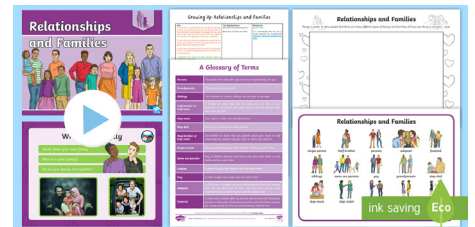
