SCHOOL UNIFORM

Introduction

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school or participating in school-organised events. Some items of uniform can be bought from our school, whilst others are easily available, at very competitive prices, at local shops, including supermarkets. A complete list of the items needed for the school uniform, including those for Physical Education, is provided below:

School Uniform

- Carnarvon school logo jumper or cardigan (or a dark navy jumper or cardigan).
- Carnarvon logo or plain white polo shirt.
- Grey or black trousers, school-style shorts or a skirt (pleated or straight).
- Spring/Summer blue checked gingham dress.
- Grey or black socks or tights.
- Black school shoes.
- A showerproof coat or winter jacket (depending on the season).

PE Kit:

- Plain black PE shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms.
- Blue Carnarvon logo t-shirt.
- Carnarvon school logo jumper or cardigan (or a dark navy jumper or cardigan).
- Black, grey or white socks.
- Trainers.

Please remember to label everything with your child's full name.

Jewellery is not allowed in school. However, where ears are pierced, only small studs may be worn and must be removed by the child for PE, games, swimming, etc.

NB: We suggest that children have their ears pierced at the beginning of the summer holiday to allow time for healing and ensure full participation in PE throughout the school year.

Long hair must be tied back.

We have school logo jumpers, cardigans, polo shirts and blue logo PE t-shirts in school. These are only available for purchase from the school.

We also have PE plain black shorts, plain white t-shirts, showerproof coats and small backpacks and book bags available.

We accept cash or card payments.

We recommend that all children wear a Carnarvon school logo jumper or cardigan if possible. Please note that we have a large selection of pre-loved uniform items available to purchase from the school office for £1 per item.
