MORNING ROUTINE



- Doors open 8:40am – children to put their bags on their pegs and come into the classroom
- All Year 4 children to come in via the front side Year 4 door (left of the main entrance of the Cawthra Building)
- Water bottles to be taken out of bags and kept in the classroom
- Snacks kept in bags
- Coats/bags on pegs
