SCHOOL TRIPS

YEAR 1 AND 2 PANTOMIME VISIT

Year 1 and 2 will visit Newark Theatre to watch the pantomime Beauty and the Beast on Monday 15th December. The coach will depart at 9am, straight after registration. The approximate return time at school is 1.30pm.

We will be exploring how the Saxons and Vikings lived, developing an understanding to support our Autumn history topic, where we are learning all about Saxon and Viking England. Huge well done Jessica!



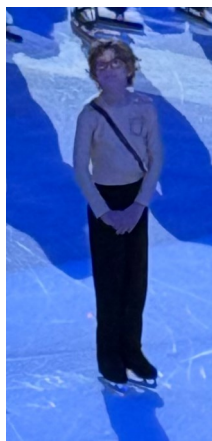
Maisie from 3AN and Freya from 2D both completed their first triathlons last month in York. They raised £360 for Cancer Research UK.
