Thank you for all your donations so far, these items are certainly keeping lunchtimes fun!



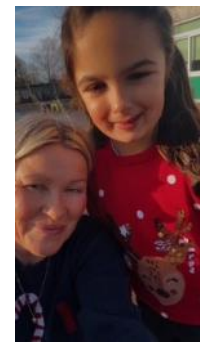
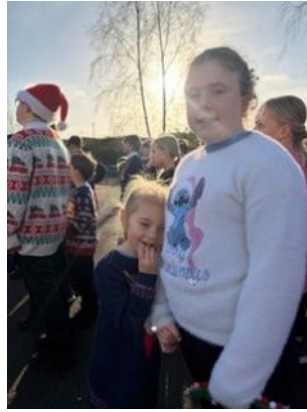
## JINGLE JOG

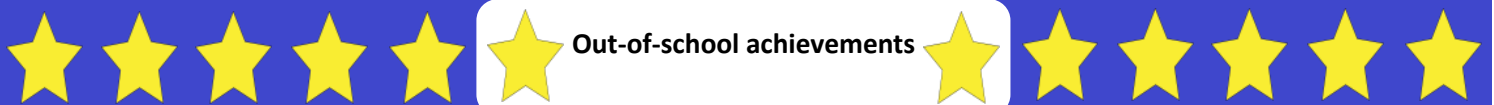

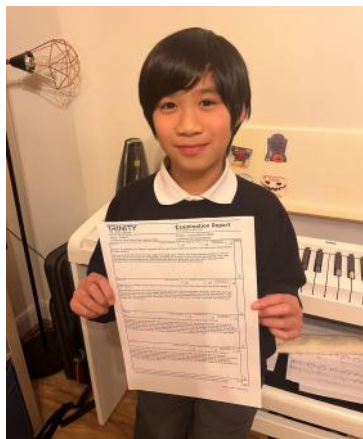
Dylan from 3AN achieved his 200M Swimming Badge . He always puts in 100% and his family are super proud!
