CAN YOU HELP?

Every year we recognise Neurodiversity Celebration Week. This has proven to be really insightful for children and staff alike, as all our knowledge and understanding grows about different types of neurodiversity, and in turn creates a greater understanding of ourselves and one another.

A couple of years ago, a parent who is neurodiverse came into school during Neurodiversity Celebration week, to talk to the children in assembly about what it meant to her to be neurodiverse – what it has enabled her to do, and how it has helped her in her career. She also came to a staff meeting and talked to staff about the impact of going through school undiagnosed and the difficulties that it had presented. It was an excellent learning opportunity for everyone.

Neurodiversity Celebration Week is March 16th-20th 2026. We will be undertaking lots of activities in school to promote further understanding.
