Out-of-school achievements

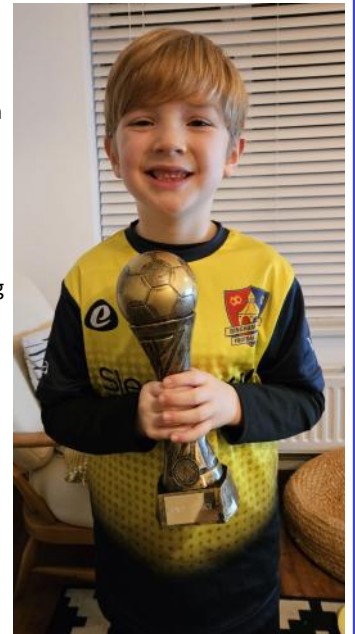


Mollie from 1BW has achieved her Stage 1 Swimming Badge and certificate. Well done Mollie!
