If you have suitable items you no longer need, please bring them to the school office.

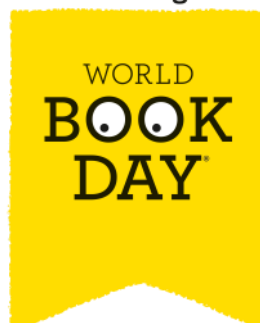

BASKETBALL RALLY

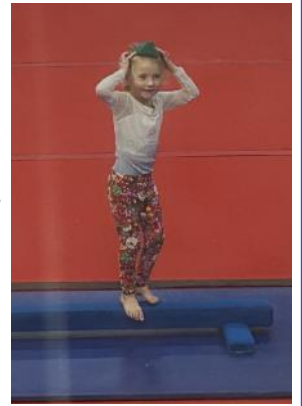
