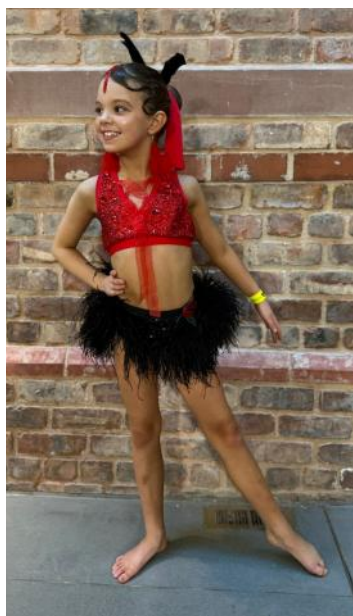


Elliot from 2B was awarded 'Training Superstar of the Week' at football on Thursday. His family are all really proud of how much effort he's putting in!
