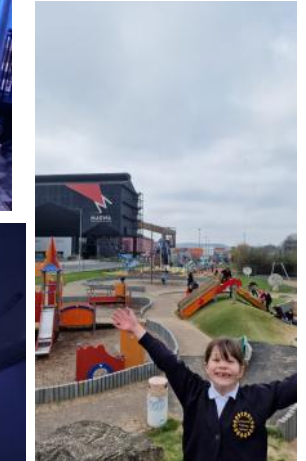


YEAR 3 VISIT MAGNA SCIENCE PARK

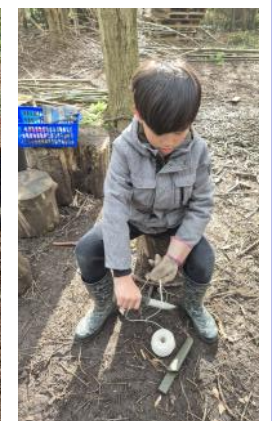
YEAR 1 GREAT FIRE OF LONDON WORKSHOP

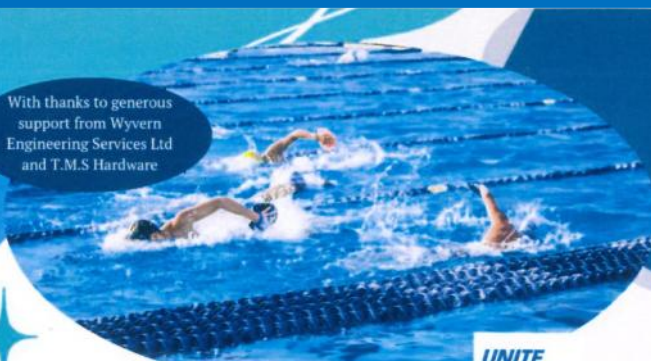
