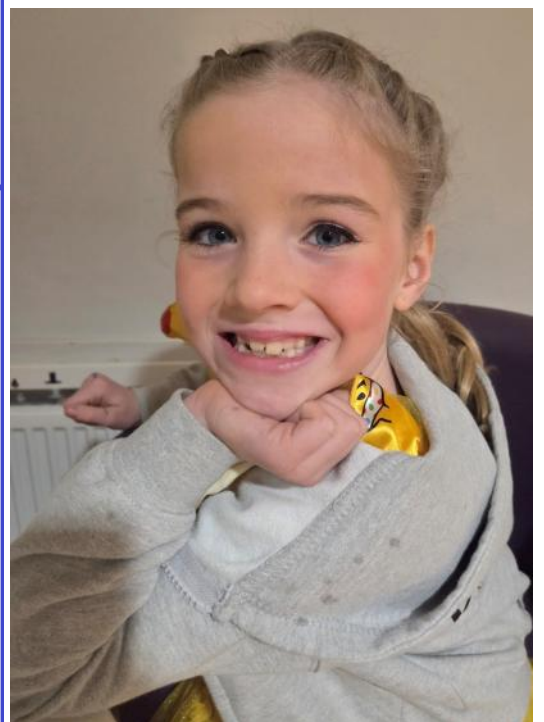


Vinnie from RLR passed Stage 1 of swimming and also swam 5 metres!
