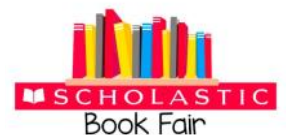

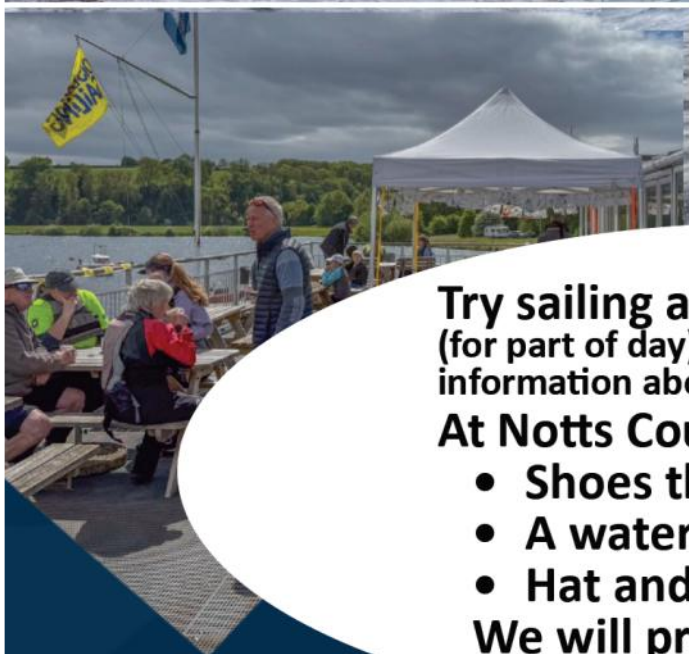

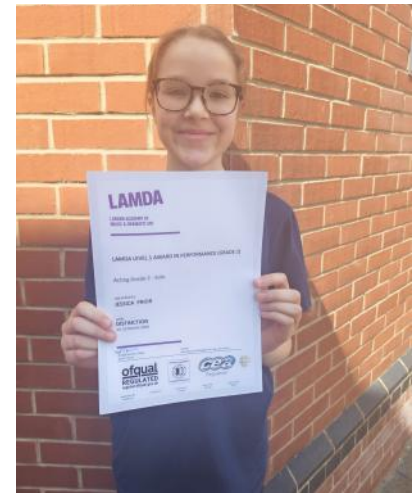


★ Out-of-school achievements ★

Jemima from 3HM won 'Player of the Match', voted by League Officials for her amazing goalkeeping in her cup final on Sunday. Her family are all very proud of her.



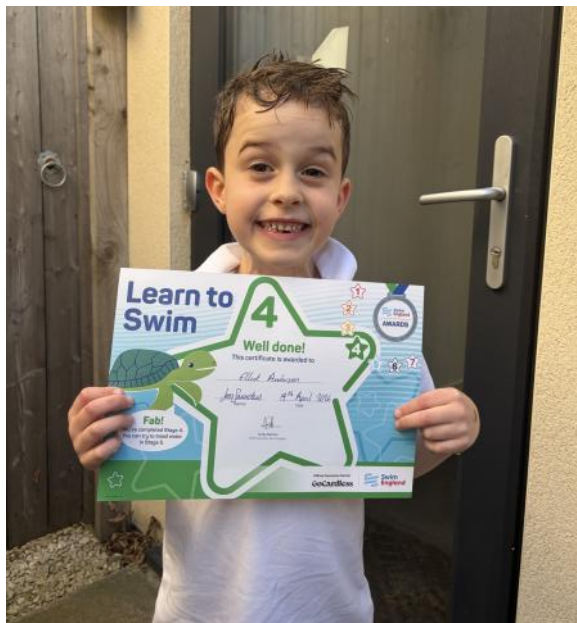
Jessica from 6H passed her LAMDA Acting Grade 2 Exam with distinction. Well done Jess, your family are very proud.


