They will be here from Friday to Sunday, as we are hosting a Chess Tournament on Saturday.

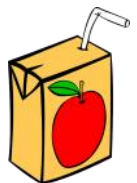

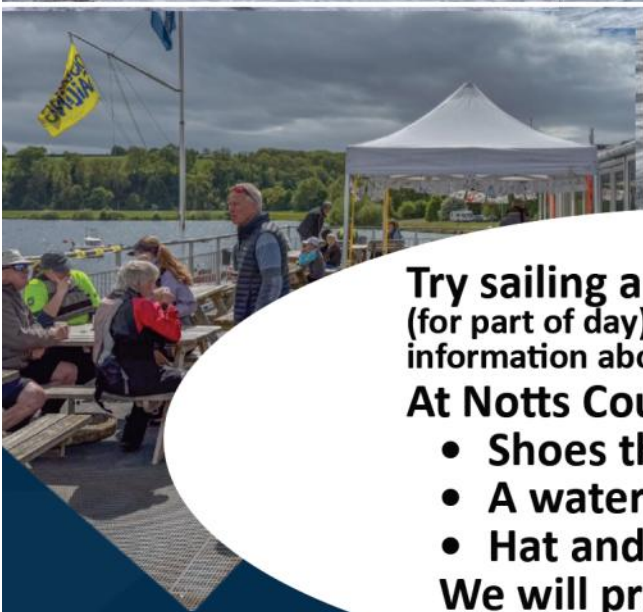
