Over the past two weeks, 3HM have been practising water safety skills during their swimming sessions at Bingham Arena.

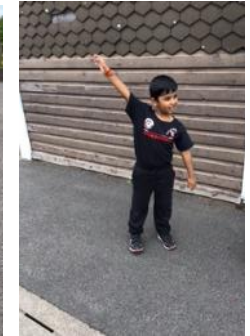

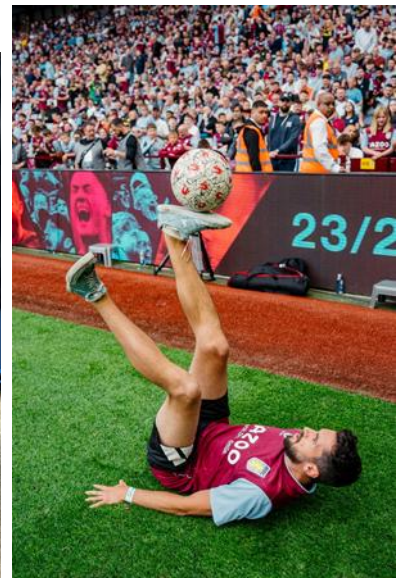
He was booked to be in school for the full day and started with an assembly for Years 2 to 6. He then spent time with every class, teaching some of his skills.

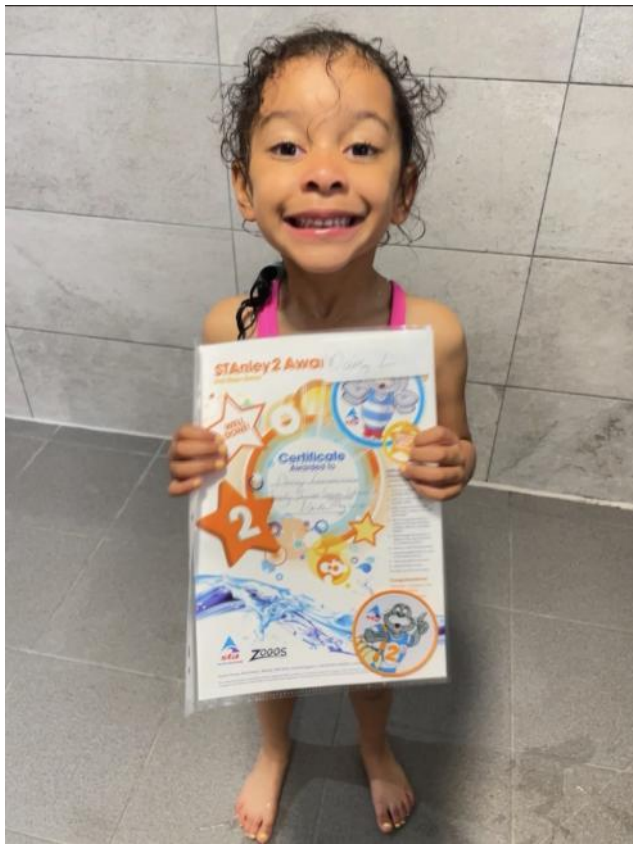

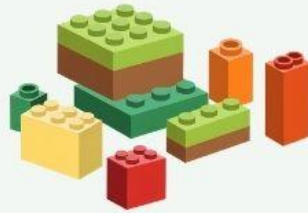
